paper clips

Do This

- Cover 3 leaves with black paper.
- Put the plant in a sunny place.

 Make sure to water the plant as needed.
- Predict what will happen to the covered leaves. Record your prediction.
- After one week, take off the paper. Record your observations. Was your prediction correct?
